About the Breakouts

There will be 15-20 breakouts selected for this conference. Each breakout will be allotted 45 minutes (to include Q&A if applicable) with a 15 - minute cushion on either side for room transition and continued individual connection. Presenters will be required to provide an accurate description of their talk and their slides for review prior to the conference. Presenters will utilize their own laptops to present. Presenters must use the microphone to ensure accessibility for all attendees

Presenters are not compensated, but will receive conference registration for the two day conference at no cost.
